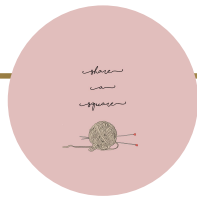


Share A Square

How To Contribute

- ▶ Stitch, Knit or Crochet 6X6 inch squares
- ▶ Then contact us for information on your nearest drop off.
- ▶ These squares will then be stitched into a bigger blanket and will then be donated to shelters and hospitals.
- ▶ Fill out our google form with your contribution so we can show you our gratitude.

Aim

- ▶ Provide safety through blankets through environmentally conscious methods
- ▶ Aid the handicraft industry and covid affected local tailors

Stitching

Any old cloth can be used for embroidery, but please ensure it is washed and clean. Stitch the hemline in and use your creativity to stitch anything on the square for aesthetic purposes, though this is not necessary.



Knitting

Approximately 50-55 cast-ons are required (adjustable according to wool size). Feel free to knit, purl or to use your creativity and form fancy patterns.



Crocheting

Approximately 7 rows of a granny square (depends on the consistency of the wool). Feel free to experiment with any type of granny square so long as it meets the size requirements.
